

WORKING INTER-PROVINCIALY DURING COVID-19

Individual construction workers or companies may work inter-provincially in several situations: on a one-time basis, for several months, or where the person, crew or company is moving back and forth between provinces.

Under the COVID-19 prevention guideline published by Manitoba Public Health, priority construction workers who travel to Manitoba from other provinces must follow the rules outlined below.

BEFORE COMING INTO MANITOBA:

- Use the WORKSAFELY COVID-19 Health Screening Tool or the Manitoba Public Health Screening Tool **BEFORE** travel.
- Do **NOT** travel if you or any family member are ill, require medical care or are COVID-19 positive or symptomatic (e.g. fever, cough or difficulty breathing).
- Bring all necessary supplies, including prescription drugs and medical supplies.
- If you are driving, get gas before entering Manitoba.

WHILE IN MANITOBA:

- Use the WORKSAFELY COVID-19 Health Screening Tool or the Manitoba Public Health Screening Tool before leaving your place of residence each day.
- Do not attend the worksite if you have a fever or other symptoms of COVID-19.
- Allow your employer to take your temperature each day before you enter the worksite. You must return home and self-isolate if you have a temperature.
- Confirm in writing with your employer before work each day that you do not have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Wear a non-medical mask while at work and in public for 14 days after arrival.
- Wash hands frequently and thoroughly.
- Practice physical distancing of two meters (six feet).
- Do not congregate in groups, and do not use public facilities such as washrooms.
- Other than work, self-isolate in residence for 14 days. Go directly to and from your workplace. Only go in public for work or for essential appointments such as essential medical treatments.
- Do not use local health providers, unless it is an emergency.
- Self-isolation is re-imposed when you leave and return to the province.

Strictly following the procedures above will minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19 on construction sites, and will be essential to minimizing infection from workers who enter or return from other provinces.
