Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Inspect work area and surroundings.
- 2) Ensure all permits have been acquired.
- 3) Perform pre-trip to machine, including back up alarm.
- 4) Check back up alarm, all gauges, hydraulics
- 5) Turn on beacon light
- 6) While traveling, allow faster traffic to pass if safe to do so
- 7) At job site, inspect area for any hazards
- 8) Load only what loader can hold and haul load close to the ground
- 9) Dump load as close as possible to delivery area
- 10) Always be aware of other workers and equipment in work area
- 11) Follow through with task carefully. Always be aware of surroundings.
- 12) Park on level ground with bucket to the ground.
- 13) Allow for enough cool down time before shutting off machine.
- 14) Close and lock doors and install window guards.
- 15) Dismount machine using 3 point contact method.

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
