Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Management will supply personal protective equipment that is appropriate for the risk of injury to a worker skin
- 2) Management will ensure adequate training for the maintenance, use and care
- 3) If a work process may create a risk to the safety / health of a worker the employer will provide the worker with:
 - A) appropriate clothing for the risk
 - B) launder or replacement of the protective clothing on a regular basis

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
