

Pneumatic Post Pounder Operation – Placing Post

**Safe Work Procedure:**

1. Using hydraulic controls, raise the impact head and open the hugger.
2. Place the post standing up straight against the roller plate cones.
3. Close the hugger arm to clamp post in (some adjustment of the roller arm may be required to hold the post firmly)
4. Post is now ready for driving.

*If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure*
