Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Pre trip inspection of scraper including hydraulics, hoses and electrical
- 2) Ensure SMV emblem is on scraper
- 3) Do not overload scraper
- 4) Ensure apron is closed while travelling
- 5) Lower scraper to ground when not in use

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
