**Safe Work Procedure:**

1. Assess the location
2. Mow the grass.
3. Cut brush that interferes with sight, obstructs signs or contributes to icy conditions, that prevents drainage
4. If traffic flow is heavy, consider posting a flag person
5. Load waste material for disposal.

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
