Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) In the event of a minor injury, report the accident to your supervisor and obtain First Aid from qualified personnel
- 2) Record injury in the First Air Record book
- 3) Fill out WCB forms
- 4) Report any further discomfort following the injury

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
