Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Inspect the location for possible hazards. Look for high traffic areas and power and water hook-ups.
- 2) Ensure that litter and debris have been removed.
- 3) Rake lawn area to remove dead grass and leaves
- 4) Pile rakes grass and leaves for composting
- 5) Dispose of stones and other inorganic material
- 6) Take note of lawn areas requiring minor site restoration
- 7) Ensure tools and equipment, including mower are in good condition
- 8) Check mowing blades for sharpness and proper height setting prior to mowing

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
