SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	To facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their workers on Protection, requirements and training.
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	 Keep the work area clean, free of oil, grease, mud, unnecessary tools/equipment, scrap metal and other materials. Clean-up spills promptly with proper absorbing materials and agents. Place all garbage and waste materials in appropriate containers. Store all oily rags in appropriate fire-approved steel containers. Keep exterior walkways and stairways free of snow, ice and obstacles. Keep interior hallways, stairwells and other traffic areas clear. Watch for hazards such as nails, pieces of scrap metal, grease and oil.
