Properly designed pig senders, receivers and test heads must be utilized for all pigging and testing operations.

 Position warning signs on each end of line to identify the "Critical" area. Check that adequate test heads are being used and properly installed. Fabricate and install test heads, temporary pig launchers and receivers. Ensure that a proper pig is being used. Position air compressor. Ensure only personnel involved with operations are on site. Use proper P.P.E. including Hearing Protection. Follow pigging safe work procedure step by step. Follow soap testing safe work procedure step by step.
