

# COVID-19 WORKSITE HEALTH SCREENING TOOL

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 and to reduce the potential risk of exposure to the workforce, please conduct this questionnaire, daily, at designated entry points, prior to accessing the site. This health screening questionnaire applies to all trades, suppliers, union reps, employees, etc.

Health screening is voluntary; however, any person who refuses to answer screening questions will be denied access to our work locations – without exception. Complying with our safety measures is in the interest of ensuring worker safety.

## SCREENING SET UP STATION

1. Have a designated location and person so that all workers and visitors to the construction site know they have to be screened.
2. Ensure physical distancing of 6 feet between person screening and all workers and visitors being screened.

## SCREENING PROCESS QUESTIONS

Workers should be asked these questions in a manner that respects their privacy. Please devise a process at your location where workers do not easily overhear co-workers who voluntarily divulge personal medical information.

Each person will be asked the following:

1. Do you have a new onset, or worsening of any ONE of the following symptoms?
  - Fever
  - Cough
  - Sore throat
  - Shortness of breath/breathing difficulties
  - New loss of taste or smell
  - Vomiting or diarrhea for more than 24 hours
2. Do you have a new onset or worsening of any TWO of the following symptoms?
  - Runny nose
  - Muscle aches
  - Fatigue
  - Conjunctivitis (pink eye)
  - Headache
  - Skin rash of unknown cause
  - Nausea or loss of appetite
3. Have you or anybody in your home had close contact (face to face contact within 2 meters/6 feet) with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
4. Have you been exposed to COVID-19 in a work or public setting?
5. Have you travelled outside of Manitoba within the last 14 days, excluding travel to western Canada, the territories or Ontario west of Terrace Bay?

If the answer is YES to ANY of the above questions, please document, notify the individual's supervisor and send the person home immediately to self-isolate for 14 days or from the day the symptoms started till they no longer have a fever and the other symptoms are gone, with a minimum isolation period of 14 days.
